

Ball Pin Cushion 2

aka "Puzzle Ball"

Please refer to *Fanciful Utility* by Anna Worden Bauersmith for specific and detailed construction techniques to complete your project.

Materials:

"outer" fabric

Wool or cotton batting

"inner" fabric

Cut 12 "lemons" of your outer fabric. Cut 24 wedges of your inner fabric.

For each segment, place an outer lemon and inner wedge right sides together. Using a running stitch, sew along the curved side. Place the second wedge against the other lemon side. Sew along this curve. Sew the flat sides closed leaving an inch.

Turn right side out. Stuff firmly with batting.

Close the opening (which will be hidden inside.)

Repeat 11 more times.


Take a group of 4 pieces. Connect one set of 4 ends into a +.

Repeat with another set of 4 pieces.

With the last 4 segments, connect them end to end into a ring with the "outer" fabrics facing outside.

Line one + group up on top of the ring so the ends meet. Attach the + ends to the ring connections

Line the other + group up with the ring so the ends meet. Attach the + ends to the ring connections.
