

# *A Gift Box*

## *Fanciful Utility Style*

This box can be made with one, two or a patchwork of fabrics.

### Materials:

1 piece of pasteboard

A fat quarter of fabric (or fabric from the scrap bag)

12"-16" of 1/4"-1/2" ribbon

Cut each piece of pasteboard and fabric using the templates. Remember to add 1/4" all around for the seam allowance.

Using your favorite *Fanciful Utility* technique, cover each piece of pasteboard with your fabric.

Connect the 4 sides. If using two fabrics, alternate (A-B-A-B)

Attach the sides to the bottom using a whip stitch.

Attach the two lid flaps you want to be on the inside first. Attach the two lids you want on the outside next.

Finish by attaching 6"-8" of ribbon at the center of the outside flaps.

Fill and gift as you wish.

Cut 4 pasteboard

Cover 2 with fabric A

Cover 2 with fabric B

Cut 1 pasteboard

Cover with fabric A (or C)

Cut 4 pasteboard

Cover 2 with fabric A

Cover 2 with fabric B
