

# *A Pyramid Box*

## *Fanciful Utility Style*

This box can be made to open on one side or to open flat.

### **Materials:**

1 piece of pasteboard

Scraps of fabric, approx 10"x16" total

1/2 yard of 1/4"-1/2" ribbon

Cut each piece of pasteboard and fabric using the templates. Remember to add 1/4" all around for the seam allowance.

Using your favorite *Fanciful Utility* technique, cover each piece of pasteboard with your fabric.

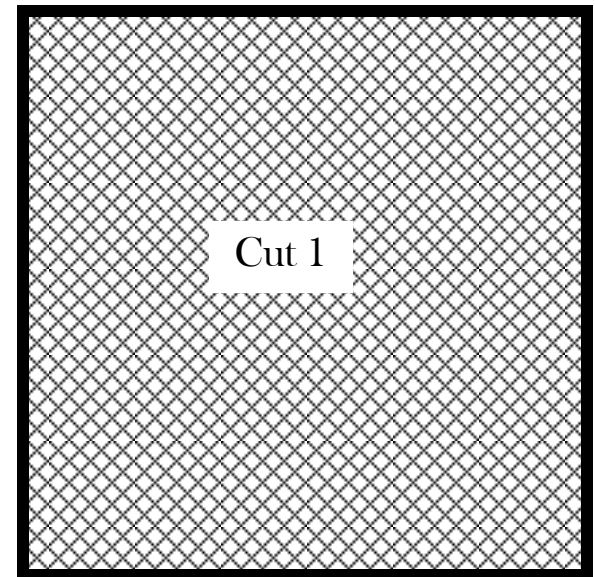
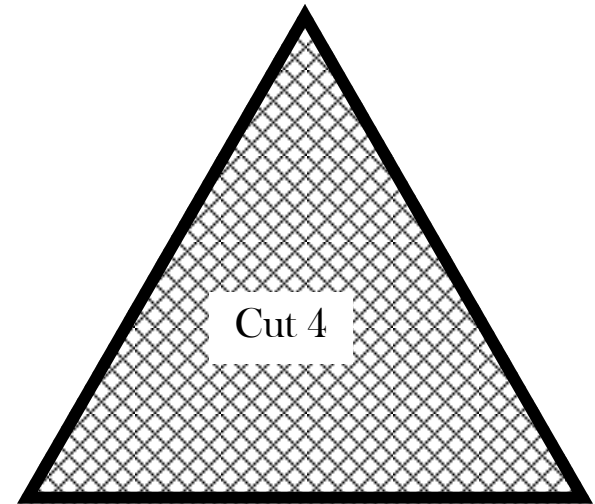
For a box that will open on one side:

- Cut the ribbon in half. Secure half the ribbon in the top point seam of the opening side and the side opposite as you cover the pasteboard.
- Whip stitch two corners, connecting three sides.
- Tie the ribbons closed.

For a box that will open flat:

- Cut 3, 1" pieces of ribbon. Fold in half to make loops. Secure these loops in the top of 3 triangles as you cover the pasteboard.
- On the 4 triangle, fold the ribbon in half securing the fold in the tip of the triangle.
- Lace the ribbon through the loops to tie closed.

Fill and gift as you wish.
