

A Take-Away Box

Fanciful Utility Style

This box can be made to open on one side or to open flat.

Materials:

1 piece of pasteboard

A fat quarter of fabric (or from the scrap bag)

1/2 yard of 1/4"-1/2" ribbon

Cut each piece of pasteboard and fabric using the templates. Remember to add 1/4" all around for the seam allowance.

Using your favorite *Fanciful Utility* technique, cover each piece of pasteboard with your fabric. (Templates arranged for space. The square is the bottom.)

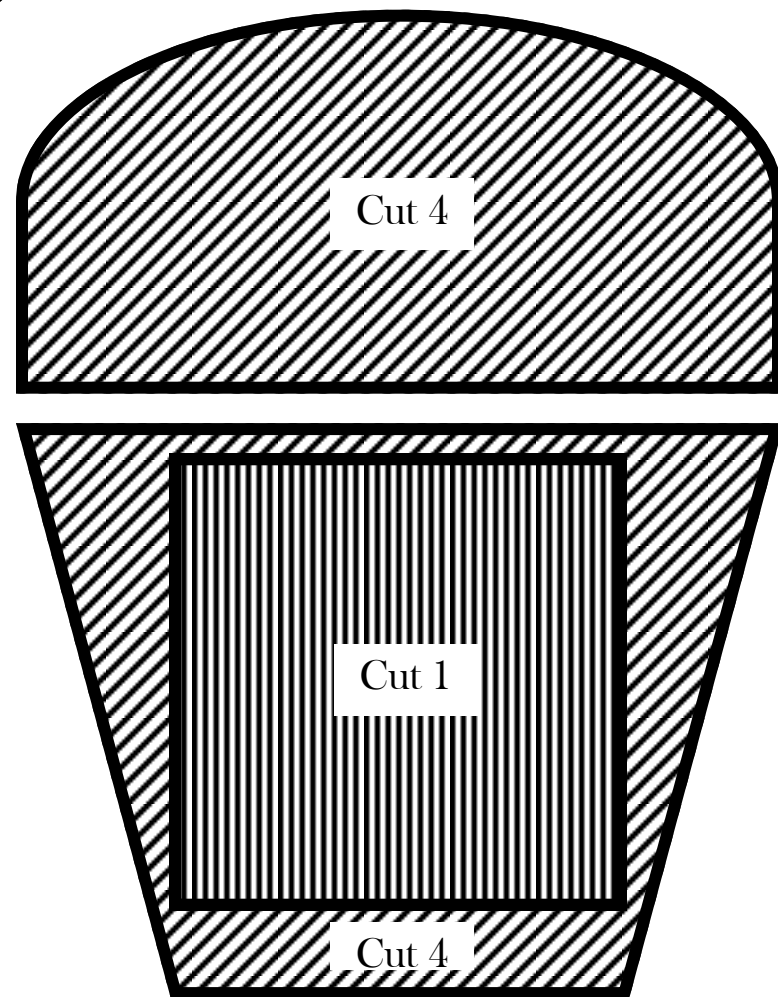
Attach the sides to the bottom using the whip stitch. If using two fabrics, alternate (A-B-A-B)

Fold the sides up, and connect along the corners with a whip stitch or blind stitch.

Attach the flaps. (It may close better if you attach the two inners first.)

Finish by wrapping the ribbon around the box, attaching it at the seams.

Fill and gift as you wish.
